**Sample Program (3 year option)) Clinical Ethics Specialization**

A Student in the Dual Degree MSB & JD program

Year 1: Normal program for a law student—31 required credits

Summer Year 1: BIE 500 Proseminar in Bioethics –on-site at Clarkson CRC (one week in Summer)

Year 2: Normal Program for a law student in both Fall and Spring semesters  
(less one course per term to be taken in Summer).

All students will do the Health Law Concentration and the Bioethics Seminar at ALS,  
This will satisfy BIE 530: Bioethics and the Law, and two Electives in the MS in Bioethics.

Fall Trimester: (Sept-Nov): BIE 590: Clinical Ethics

Winter Trimester (Jan-Mar): BIE 610: On-Line Practicum

Spring Trimester (March –June) BIE 620: On-Site Clinical Practicum (1 week at Icahn) (1<sup>st</sup> week of June)  
BIE 650: Capstone Part 1 (1 week at UGC) (2<sup>nd</sup> week of June)

Summer Year 2: 2 law courses

Year 3 Normal Program for a law student in both Fall and Spring semesters. **(less 12 Law School credits)**  
(And you will not need to do the traditional Law school upper class writing requirement)

Fall Trimester: (Sept-Nov): BIE 510: Biomedical Ethics  
BIE 630: Masters Project I

Winter Trimester: Jan-March) BIE 520: Health Care Policy  
BIE 640: Masters Project II

Spring: Trimester: (March-June) BIE 650: Capstone Part 2 (Present project)
